Life Background. Joseph Campbell was born in White Plains, New York, on March 26, 1904, the son of Josephine (née Lynch) and Charles William Campbell. He was from an upper-middle-class Irish Catholic family. During his childhood, he moved with his family to nearby New Rochelle, New York. In 1911, a fire destroyed the family home in New Rochelle, killing his grandmother.
